IECMH Consultants provide specialized support by providing consultation to the Prenatal to age six field in the following ways:

#### Home/Classroom Focused

Collaborating with families and early childhood staff to promote warm, trusting relationships, steady routines, and development enhancing interactions that positively impact classroom and home climates.



### **Child and Family Specific**

Collaborating with families and/or staff to understand and respond to a child's or parent's mental health needs, behavioral difficulties, and/or developmental challenges



#### **Programmatic**

Systemic Approach that aims to have a program wide impact, which focuses on equity and inclusion, and social emotional climate issues impacting multiple staff and children/ families
